

...on YB Dato' Sri Hajjah Nancy Shukri, Minister of Women, Family and Community Development who was appointed to the portfolio in December 2022, to reiterate MASW's position and the importance of the Bill in enhancing social work practice in the country.



With the technical and financial support from UNICEF Malaysia, we are learning and are being guided to be more strategic and consistent in making MASW and social work more visible. Through the launching of the 'Heroes Among Us' video and advocacy campaign, we are making steps policy in engaging makers, parliamentarians, media, social work students, as well as to the general public in enhancing the professional image of social work and social workers. Although the Social Work Profession Bill was not tabled in 2023, we have seen some encouraging progress and we will continue to intensify our efforts in 2024.

In celebrating the 50th anniversary of the formation of MASW, we co-organized the inaugural National Social Work Summit with Institut Social Malaysia (ISM) on the 23 and 24 August at ISM. The MASW 50th anniversary dinner on 23 August was graced by YABhg Tun Jeanne Abdullah as the guest of honour. During the anniversary dinner, we honoured our past presidents and presented certificate of appreciation to those who are still with us.

In 2023, MASW also collaborated with ISM in organizing five series of seminar on Social Work Profession and Continuing Professional Development (CPD) from February until September 2023. This is in line with our efforts in promoting the social work profession and the preparedness for CPD when the Social Work Profession Bill is passed in the future. ISM has agreed to continue the collaboration in 2024, so do watch out for the announcements. We would also like to extend our gratitude and appreciation to ISM for recognizing MASW as one of its Strategic Partners for 2023.

In addition, the 15th Eurasia Forum on Social Work is scheduled to be held on 20-22 March 2024 in Pattaya, Thailand. #### 27TH ASIA PACIFIC SOCIAL WORK REGIONAL CONFERENCE 5TH - 7TH NOVEMBER 2023

The 27th Asia Pacific Social Work Regional Conference was held from November 4-7 in Cebu City, Philippines. It was co-organized by the International Federation of Social Workers-Asia Pacific (IFSW-AP), the Association of the Asia Pacific Social Work Educators (APASWE), and the Philippines Association of Social Workers Inc. (PASWI). The conference had the theme 'Sustainable Development Goals Halfway Points: Social Work Contributions to Social Development.' IFSW Global President, Mr. Joachim Cuthbert Mumba, IFSW-AP Regional President, Prof. Machiko Ohara, APASWE Secretary, Dr. Jowima Reyes, and PASWI President, Roy Luntayao, addressed and welcomed over 1000 participants. Approximately 150 international participants from 17 countries across the region took part in this biannual conference. A pre-conference workshop on 'Disaster Preparedness, Mitigation, and Rehabilitation: Social Work Perspective' was held on November 4. IFSW-AP and APASWE conducted their General Meetings on November 5th and 6th, respectively.



President of MASW, Dr. Teoh Ai Hua, was invited as a plenary speaker on the theme 'Transformative Leadership and SDGs,' while life member of MASW, Datuk Dr. Denison Jayasooria, was among the invited keynote speakers. MASW member Dr. Haizzan Yahaya from Universiti Sains Malaysia participated in the regional conference as a board member of APASWE. Dr. Teoh also represented MASW at the IFSW-AP General Meeting. Sri Lanka will host the 28th Regional Conference in 2025.



#### 18TH ASEAN GO-NGO FORUM ON SOCIAL WELFARE AND DEVELOPMENT **13TH - 14TH NOVEMBER 2023**

The 18th ASEAN GO-NGO Forum on Social Welfare and Development, with the theme 'Responsive Social Protection in the Changing World,' was held in Ha Long City, Vietnam, on 13 and 14 November 2023. The GO-NGO Forum was one of the main events in line with the 19th ASEAN Senior Officials Meeting on Social Welfare and Development (SOMSWD) held from 15-17 November.

The Malaysian official delegation was led by Datuk Maziah bt Che Yusof, Secretary-General of the Ministry of Women, Family, and Community Development (KPWKM) and Head of Malaysia SOMSWD, accompanied by Puan Wan Noraida, Deputy Director-General of the Department of Social Welfare, and Cik Anis Nabihah from the Policy and International Relations of the Ministry.

MASW President Dr. Teoh Ai Hua was appointed by the KPWKM as one of the Malaysian delegates representing MASW and the National Council of Welfare and Social Development Malaysia (MAKPEM), of which Dr. Teoh is one of its Vice Presidents. In addition, Dr. Teoh was also invited to the Forum in his capacity as the Regional President of the International Council on Social Welfare-South East Asia and Pacific Region (ICSW-SEAP) by the host Ministry of Labour, Invalids, and Social Affairs of Vietnam.





At the GO-NGO Forum, delegates from the government sector, UN agencies, NGOs, and CSOs discussed and made recommendations four on aspects, namely:

disability-inclusive Ensuring approaches and strategies on

social protection;

ii. Empowering older persons through integrated social protection; iii. Protecting children through comprehensive child-focused social protection; and

#### ASEAN SOCIAL WORK CONSORTIUM CONFERENCE 6TH & 7TH DECEMBER 2023



The 11th and 12th ASEAN Social Work Consortium (ASWC) Conference, organized by the Philippines, was held online on 6 and 7 December with the theme 'Strengthening the Role of Social Work: Responding to the Changing Socio-Economic, Environmental, and Political Landscapes in ASEAN.' The ASWC aims to provide a venue for social



work educators, practitioners, and advocates from ASEAN Member States (AMS) to:

(i) share initiatives and innovations in strengthening the role of social work along the priority areas of the ASWC Work Plan 2021-2025;

(ii) strengthen partnerships and collaborations in social work practice and education among AMS;

(iii) discuss and exchange perspectives on building positive public perceptions of Social Work; and

(iv) discuss ways forward to further strengthen the role of social work in responding to the changing socio-economic, environmental, and political landscapes in ASEAN.

Malaysian delegates were comprised of representatives from the Ministry of Women, Family, and Community Development, the Department of Social Welfare, and medical social workers from the Ministry of Health and the Prison Department. Dr. Teoh Ai Hua represented MASW at the conference and presented the outcomes of the group discussion on social work education.




